



What to do after an Accident:



Be Prepared:

- Keep an emergency kit in your car.
- It also helps to have a pen and a card with any relevant medical information for you and your family.

What to do:

- Stay Calm!
- Make sure everyone is okay – call 911 if you need to.
- Call the police.
- If accident is minor, move cars to a safe place, out of traffic.
- Turn on your car's hazard lights and use cones, warning triangles or flares for safety.
- Make sure to get the other driver's information:
 - ✓ Name
 - ✓ Phone number
 - ✓ Address
 - ✓ Insurance provider & policy number
 - ✓ Driver's license number
 - ✓ Vehicle make and model
- Take pictures of the scene and vehicles involved .
- Contact your insurance company and report the accident.



Tips:

- Don't sign any documents unless its for the police.
- Do not admit fault.
