# **BEST PRACTICES**

California Car Seat Law:
As of January 1, 2017, CA law requires that all children under age 2 must be rear-facing unless 40 inches tall.

INFANT



#### **Rear Facing Infant & Convertible Seats**

- •NEVER in front of an airbag
- •Keep rear facing to upper weight or height limit or two years old
- •Harness snug and at or below shoulders
- Chest clip at armpit level
- •Attach to car with seat belt or lower anchors
- •No after-market products

# **TODDLER**



#### **Forward Facing Seats**

- •Up to 40 85 pounds
- •Harness snug at or above shoulders
- Chest clip at armpit level
- •Attach to car with top tether strap and seat belt or lower anchors
- •Use a 5-point harness to upper weight or height limit of seat

# **BOOSTER**



#### **Booster Seats**

- •Until 4' 9" and 8-12 years
- •Always use lap/shoulder seat belt
- •Never put shoulder belt behind back or under arm
- •Use highback booster for vehicle seat without headrest

# SAFETY BELT



#### **Adult-size Seat Belts**

- •Back straight against vehicle seat and knees bent at seat edge
- •Shoulder belt across chest, not neck or throat
- •Lap belt low and snug across upper thighs, not stomach
- •Children younger than 13 should always ride in the back seat
